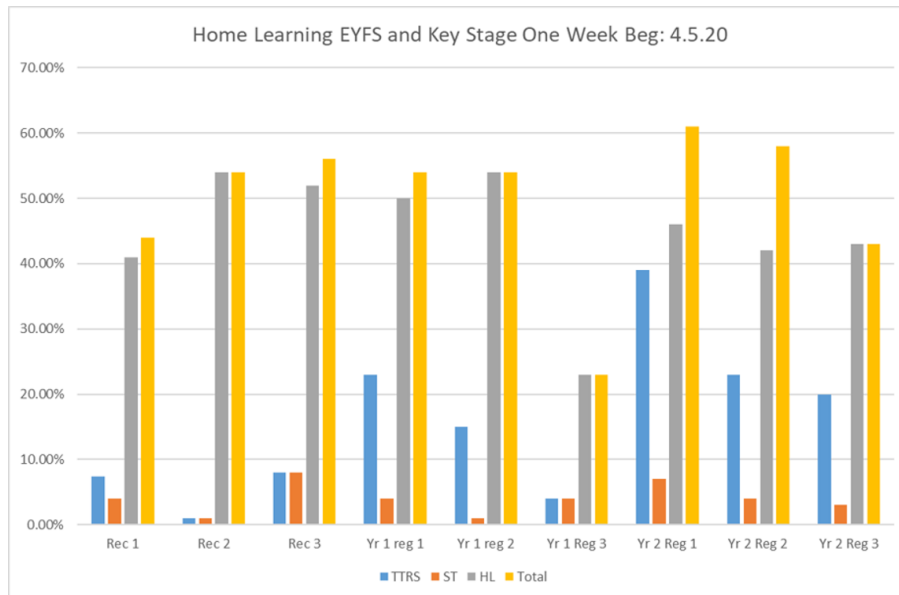
This week's results are in! A special mention to Year 1 this week who have earned their highest ever score —well done! A huge win for the boys too this week—let's see if the girls fight back next week....

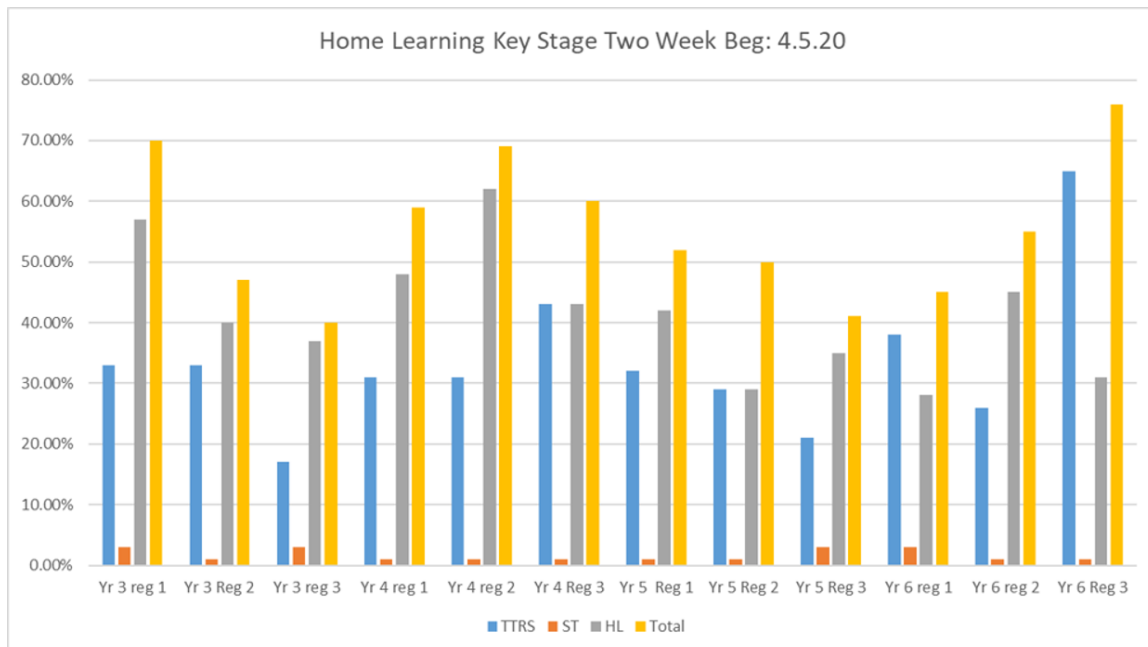
# Home learning class champions

Our home learning class champions in EYFS and KS1 this week are Year 2 Reg 1 with 61% of children completing home learning this week—well done!



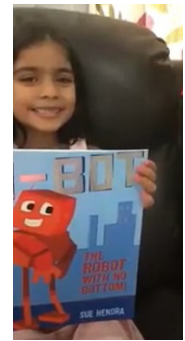
Our home learning class champions in KS2 this week are Year 6 Reg 3 with 76% of children completing home learning this week—well done!
