Induction days


We are so excited to see all of you next week. Here is a reminder of the day that each year group is having their induction day:

Thursday 16 th July	Year 5	Year 6	Entrance next to school office
Friday 17 th July	Reception	Year 1	Entrance next to East Park

Roots and Shoots induction day is Wednesday 15th July—entrance next to school office.


One way system

A one way system will in be place next week and year groups need to enter from the entrances listed above. The following entrance signs will be in place along with direction arrows throughout our school grounds:

ENTRANCE ONLY for Yrs 2, RECEPTION, 1, 3 & 4
 ALL PARENTS TO FOLLOW ONE WAY SYSTEM AROUND THE SCHOOL SITE 

- YOUR CHILD MUST STAY WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES AND MUST NOT USE ANY PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT
- Do not arrive on the school site any earlier than 5 minutes before you drop off or collect your child.
- Make sure that your child has everything they need for the day as there is NO ACCESS TO SCHOOL OFFICE.
- Always ensure that you use the markers on the playground floor to drop off and collect your child.
- Ensure that you or someone from your household can be contacted immediately during the school day.
- DO NOT INTERACT with other parents whilst on school site.



ENTRANCE ONLY for Yrs 5 and 6
 ALL PARENTS TO FOLLOW ONE WAY SYSTEM AROUND THE SCHOOL SITE 

- YOUR CHILD MUST STAY WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES AND MUST NOT USE ANY PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT
- Do not arrive on the school site any earlier than 5 minutes before you drop off or collect your child.
- Make sure that your child has everything they need for the day as there is NO ACCESS TO SCHOOL OFFICE.
- Always ensure that you use the markers on the playground floor to drop off and collect your child.
- Ensure that you or someone from your household can be contacted immediately during the school day.
- DO NOT INTERACT with other parents whilst on school site.

Staff will be able to help you to locate your child's new classroom if you are unsure.

Staff and PPE

At the start and end of the day you will see staff wearing PPE—this will include a visor and gloves. Parents and children are welcome to wear face masks to and from school however these are not to be worn inside school.



School prevention measures

Below is the set of actions that we have put in place in school for our induction days:

- If you, your child or someone in your household has symptoms you must not attend school
- Children and staff will clean their hands thoroughly more often than usual and will use the available hand sanitiser
- We will promote good respiratory hygiene by using the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach
- Enhanced cleaning has been introduced
- Contact will be minimised by children only mixing with their own class 'bubble' - this will include playtimes and lunchtimes
- The school hall will not be used for lunchtime or assemblies to ensure that children can remain in their own bubble
- Staff will wear PPE where appropriate including when providing intimate care to identified pupils or first aid
- School procedures are in place for a child who presents with symptoms



Hand sanitiser dispensers are now situated throughout school, including one per classroom



Items to bring to school

On their induction day, children must bring in a packed lunch, a water bottle and an inhaler if required. Can children also return any reading books or library books on this day too. We ask that children do not bring a school bag with them as corridor cupboards will not be in use.
