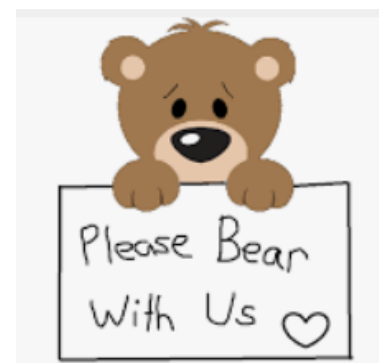

Nursery

Year 6

Year 6 home learning will have 'Transition to Year 7 and mental health/well being' as a focus over the next four weeks. Each week Year 6 parents/carers will receive a PDF via ParentMail with daily activities for children to engage in that will aim to ease their transition to Secondary school and celebrate the end of their time here at East Park.



These resources will be uploaded as Files on Teams for the children to access independently; resources will also include interviews with some of their Secondary teachers, quizzes and challenges. Teams will also be used to provide live support sessions to small groups of children who will be grouped according to the secondary school they are attending. Ensure children check their 'Calendar' on Teams at **9am every Monday morning** so they know when a meeting is scheduled!

Assemblies

Our class assemblies are changing slightly from next week. Assemblies will now take place on Fridays only—children in Roots and Shoots, Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 will have their assembly shared on YouTube at 1pm and children in Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 will have their assembly shared on YouTube at 2pm—just like it would be if we were all together at school.
