We still have a few places available in our nursery for September. If your child is currently 3, or will be 3 by August 31st, you can apply for a place and start with us during the Autumn term. We offer a morning and afternoon 15 hour provision with the following timings:

Morning nursery: 8:30—1130

Afternoon nursery: 12:20—320

We also offer 30 hour provision (8:30—3:20) for children who are eligible for this funding.
