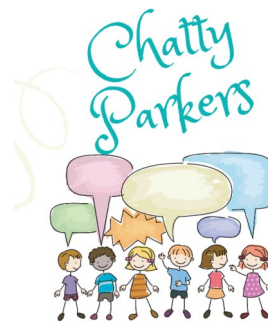


Chatty Parkers
