Our Reception phonics workshops are taking place next week and parents are invited on the following days:

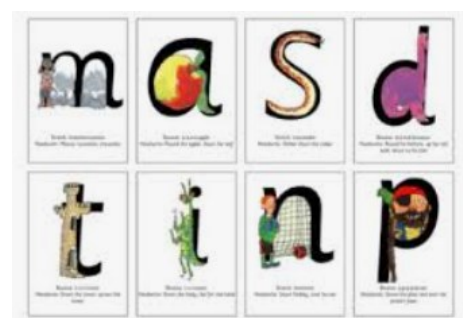
Tuesday 31st January at 9am—Reg 1
