Year 4 Newsletter Summer term

English

In English this term we will be focusing on a text called "George's Marvellous Medicine". We will be focusing on writing character descriptions, instructions, and short narratives,

Maths

In Year 4 this term we will continue to learn more about the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division) and link think to everyday problem and reasoning questions.

Curious Curriculum



This term we will start by learning about the Stone Age, Bronze, and Iron Age. Whilst looking through these periods of time, we will look at how people lived during these times, cave drawings, hunters and gather, how bronze was introduced



RE

We are learning about many different places from different religions, finding out what it is like in the buildings, what people do there and how they care for and show respect to their sacred places. We will be completing artwork, circle time discussions and written activities about the different sacred places.

PE

This term we will be focusing on perfecting our cricket, rounders, and athletics skills.

This will include getting ready for our annual Sports Day. and then Reg 3 will be swimming all term every Thursday afternoon — look out for more information about this.

MFI

This term in French, we will be focusing on a topic called "Going shopping" which will look at names of fruit and vegetables, clothes and general phrases to help when shopping. Later we will look at a new unit called "Where in the world" which will focus on the UK, animals, and continents.

Music

This term we will be learning songs about the Stone Age. One is the epic unison song called "Living in the new Stone Age" and the other is called "Two piles of stone" This song tells the story of how two piles of stone made up a pyramid in Egypt and Stonehenge.

Computing

We will be learning how weather data is collected and analysed. Children will create their own weather stations. They will research and analyse weather-based data and will learn to use spreadsheets to record data they have collected themselves.

Art/Design

This term we will be having a full week of Art to support our topic on Stonge age. Children will get the chance to sketch and paint and perfect their skills.
