Spring term

English

Text: Mystery of the Egyptian Amulet Writing Opportunities: Setting description, balanced arguments, newspaper article, narrative and persuasion.

Maths

We will be learning about measures, area, perimeter and volume, time, angles, circles, statistics, data, ratio, algebra, negative numbers and the four operations.



Curious Curriculum

This term we are learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will learn about the geography of Egypt and the River Nile and the reasons why the Ancient Egyptians settled near the Nile. Children will investigate mummification, the life of Cleopatra and the impact that the Ancient Egyptians had on modern day life.



RE

Our topic for this term is called Values: What Matters Most? We will be learning about Christians and Humanists and discuss their beliefs.



Our two areas of learning this term are 'Dance' and 'Gymnastics'. We will focus on balance, sequencing movement, evaluation, performance



What will the focus be for French in two terms, e.g transport
